Type of public transportation in the area: Buses nearby

The nearest big city: Marbella, Fuengirola, Málaga (nearest to furthest). On the west side, Algeciras and Gibraltar.

The nearest airport: Málaga (east), Gibraltar (west).

The nearest railway station: Málaga.

Gym / Entertainment: Some gyms in town centre and lots of bars in the city centre and the marina area. No shopping centres. The nearest are in Marbella.

Free time/ Culture and leisure programme: Auditorio Felipe VI (Theatre) just next to the school with performances and music. Padre Manuel Cultural centre very near the school with free-time activities and cultural programme.

Post Office: two offices, one in the town center, another one near our school (Huerta Nueva).

There are numerous rental agencies that you can contact, and also some websites and apps, such as the Idealista app and http://www.enalquiler.com/ or http://www.segundamano.es/ Also, once you get to the school, some teachers may help you find a rental apartment (belonging to someone they know), and there are usually advertisements for flats or rooms to rent for teachers displayed on the notice board, so I would recommend staying at an Airbnb the first week(s) and look for an apartment once you are here.
